EC Elections 2019

- 2019 JCP EC Election results are published ~ 30% voter participation:
- <https://jcp.org/aboutJava/communityprocess/elections/2019.html>
- JCP EC now has 21 Members; per JCP 2.11.10:
- For the 2019 annual elections, three Ratified and one Elected Seats will be eliminated, thereby reducing the EC to 21 members.
- For the 2020 annual elections, two Ratified and one Elected Seats will be eliminated, thereby reducing the EC to 18 members.

EC Elections 2019

- EC Seats Elections completed:
 - Ratified Seats: ARM, Fujitsu, IBM, Intel and Sociedade de Usários da Tecnologia Java - SouJava
 - Elected: Twitter, Tomitribe
 - Associate: Marcus Biel, Ken Fogel (one year term)
 - Credit Suisse, Hazelcast, HPE did not run for election
